Eliminating Backlog of Untested Sexual Assault Kits



Attorney General Bondi's Weekly Briefing

January 26, 2018

Great news this week in our campaign to eliminate the backlog of untested sexual assault kits. The latest progress report just issued by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement shows the state processed more than 6,000 kits. I am thrilled by the

progress we have made as we approach our goal of testing 8,600 by June of 2019.

Processing these previously untested kits unlocks DNA evidence that can be used to solve crimes and bring some closure to sexual assault victims. So far testing these kits has produced 1,461 hits in key DNA databases. One of those DNA matches led to the recent arrest of a Virginia man on charges related to a 20-year-old sexual battery in Fort Myers. Our campaign to eliminate the backlog breathed new life into this cold case—and I believe more cases will be solved through our efforts.

In 2015, I gathered law enforcement, prosecutors, sexual assault survivors and advocates together to request that the backlog be tested. In the 2016 legislative session, I worked with lawmakers to secure the funding needed to tackle this enormous task. Working together we secured the necessary resources, and today, I am encouraged by how fast we are approaching our goal.

Tampa 3rd in Job Creation

TAMPA, Fla. — Today, Governor Rick Scott announced that the Tampa area added 28,000 new private-sector jobs in the last year, creating the third-highest number of jobs among all Florida metro areas. Tampa's unemployment rate dropped to 3.4 percent, down 1.1 percentage points from one year ago. Statewide, Florida businesses created

nearly 30,000 new jobs in December bringing the total number of new private-sector jobs created in Florida to 1,497,100 since December 2010.

Governor Scott said, "Last year ended strong with 28,000 new jobs created in the Tampa Bay area. Statewide, nearly 1.5 million jobs have been created since December 2010, and it is clear that we are on track to making Florida the best place in the nation for families to find new opportunities."

The industries with the highest growth over the year in Tampa were professional and business services with 7,000 new jobs and education and health services with 6,100 new jobs.

The Tampa area remained first among the state metro areas in job demand in December with 40,143 openings. The Tampa area also continues to rank first in the state in demand for high-skill, high-wage STEM occupations with 13,179 openings in December.

As of December, Florida's unemployment rate is at 3.7 percent, a drop of 7.0 percentage points since December 2010, faster than the national decline of 5.2 percentage points. In the last year, 185,000 people entered Florida's labor force, a growth of 1.9 percent, which is nearly four times the national labor force growth rate of only 0.5 percent.

In December, 18,828 Floridians were placed in jobs by CareerSource Tampa Bay and the state's other 23 local workforce boards.

A Flood of 'Flood Cars'

(NAPSI)—Recent research suggests drivers may be behind the wheel of more than 325,000 previously flooded vehicles. That's a 20 percent increase from 2016 and a

stark reminder to consumers to do due diligence when used-car shopping.

One Woman's Story

"I bought a car last year and the seller never told us anything about it being a flood car," said Charlene Geiger from Pennsylvania. "When we got home and ran a Carfax, there it was—a flood car from Hurricane Sandy. It showed that the seller bought it as a salvage car and the title was washed when he brought it to Pennsylvania. We lost \$16,000 over all of it."

Where To Be Most Wary

Vehicles reported as flood damaged by a state's Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), insurance companies and more have washed up in every state. These 10 have the most:

1. Texas—51,000
2. Louisiana—29,000
3. Pennsylvania—20,000
4. Florida—19,000
5. Kentucky—16,000
6. Illinois—15,000

7. South Carolina—13,000
8. Virginia—13,000
9. North Carolina—13,000
10. Michigan—11,000.

In addition, several hundred thousand more flooded cars may emerge from Hurricanes Harvey and Irma.

Historically, about half the vehicles damaged by floods end up back on the market. Flooded cars rot from the inside out as water corrodes the mechanical parts, shorts the electrical system, and compromises safety features like air bags and anti-lock brakes. Health concerns are an added problem, as mold and bacteria permeate the soft parts of the car.

Honey-Sriracha Grilled Chicken



Ingredients

- 6 tablespoons Sriracha sauce
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 8 bone-in chicken thighs, skinned
- 2 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro

Directions

1. Whisk together 2 tablespoons of the Sriracha sauce and the honey; set aside. Place the chicken in a resealable plastic bag and add remaining Sriracha sauce and the lime juice. Seal; turn bag to coat chicken. Let stand 15 minutes.
2. Grill chicken on the greased rack of a covered gas or charcoal grill directly over medium heat for 30 to 35 minutes or until done (at least 175 degrees F), turning 3 or 4 times.
3. Remove chicken to a platter; brush with honey mixture. Cover and let stand 5 minutes. Sprinkle with cilantro.

Drugless help with tension headaches

The most common type of headache is caused by tension, usually due -- in whole or part -- to stress on the nervous system. The stress may be caused by emotions, noise and fluorescent lighting, chemical stressors or by misalignment of the spinal bones of the neck, called cervical vertebrae.

Head and neck trauma often occurs as a result of a motor vehicle accident (MVA). Mild brain injury can cause headaches -- and the head trauma is an indication of great forces having been transmitted through the neck, as well as through the brain. The plates of the skull normally have some movement and can be jammed during head

trauma. Craniosacral therapy works to restore natural movement of those plates. Craniosacral practitioners use light-touch techniques to determine the movement -- or lack thereof -- in the plates of the skull and membranes covering the brain and spinal cord and cerebrospinal fluid (CSF), which runs from the skull to the sacrum. Restoring motion of the skull increases the movement of the CSF, which decreases head pain.

Cervical exams and x-ray studies reveal the presence or absence of cervical nerve interference. This nerve interference can cause headaches after a trauma such as an MVA -- and the pain may gradually occur and worsen days or weeks after the injury, however minor it may have seemed at the

time. After neck trauma, the sufferer is more likely to have headaches triggered by stress than a normal, healthy person. Stiffness results from untreated misalignments in the neck. Pain of the neck or head, stiffness and/or dizziness often result from untreated whiplash as well as increased sensitivity to light and sound. The strain-sprain of muscles and ligaments in whiplash causes a loss of the forward curve of the neck which acts as a shock absorber. Spinal arthritis results after a loss of the normal forward curve of the neck because each jolt experienced is absorbed by the discs instead of by the forward neck curve. The resulting stress on the ligaments causes a negative charge around them, while calcium is positively charged. Calcium is attracted to the negative charge and binds to ligaments under stress, resulting in bony spurs. This may be reversible with gentle spinal manipulation or adjustments.

If you have been in an auto accident it is important to be checked out by a chiropractor within two weeks to see if damage was done which can be helped for a long term change vs temporary relief via medication. Orlando Area Leader in Job Creation

Gov. Scott: Orlando Area Remains Leader in Job Creation

ORLANDO, Fla. — Today, Governor Rick Scott announced that the Orlando area had the highest job creation in the state for the fifth month in a row, adding 46,300 new private-sector jobs in the last year. The unemployment rate in Orlando was 3.3 percent, down 1.0 percentage point from one year ago. Statewide, Florida businesses created nearly 30,000 new jobs in December bringing the total number of new private-sector jobs created in Florida to 1,497,100 since December 2010.

Governor Scott said, "For the fifth month in a row, the Orlando area led the state with the most jobs created, which is great news for families in Central Florida. Every job is an opportunity for a Floridian to provide for their family, and I look forward to another great year of job creation in 2018."

Orlando led the state in job growth over

the year in the following industries:

- Leisure and hospitality with 10,900 new jobs;
- Professional and business services with 10,800 new jobs; and
- Manufacturing with 5,600 new jobs.

In December, the Orlando area was once again second among state metro areas in job demand with 34,410 job openings. Orlando also remained the second-highest metro area in demand for high-skill, high-wage STEM occupations with 10,157 openings.

As of December, Florida's unemployment rate is at 3.7 percent, a drop of 7.0 percentage points since December 2010, faster than the national decline of 5.2 percentage points. In the last year, 185,000 people entered Florida's labor force, a growth of 1.9 percent, which is nearly four times the national labor force growth rate of only 0.5 percent.

In December, 18,828 Floridians were

placed in jobs by CareerSource Central Florida and the state's other 23 local workforce boards.

Internet and Email Scams

As the Chief of Police for the Town of Lady Lake I am often asked, "What can I do to stop folks from becoming a victim of a scam?" I can tell you the most important thing we all can do is pass the following information along to our friends, family and co-workers so they are aware of these common scams and prevent them from becoming a potential target.

Phishing

The most widespread internet and email scam today is the modern day "sting" con

game. "[Phishing](#)" is where digital thieves lure you into divulging your password info through convincing emails and web pages. These phishing emails and web pages resemble legitimate credit authorities like Citibank, eBay, or PayPal. They frighten or entice you into visiting a phony web page and entering your ID and password. Commonly, the guise is an urgent need to "confirm your identity". They will even offer you a story of how your account has been attacked by hackers to lure you into entering your confidential information.

The email message will require you to click on a link. But instead of leading you to the real login https: site, the link will secretly

redirect you to a [fake website](#). You then innocently enter your ID and password. This information is intercepted by the scammers, who later access your account and fleece you for your hard earned money.

This phishing con, like all cons, depends on people believing the legitimacy of their emails and web pages. Because it was born out of hacking techniques, "fishing" is stylistically spelled "phishing" by hackers.

Tip: the beginning of the link address should have https://. Phishing fakes will just have http:// (no "s"). If still in doubt, make a phone call to the financial institution to verify if the email is legit. In the meantime, if an email seems suspicious to you, do not trust it. Being skeptical could save you hundreds, if not thousands, of lost dollars.

The Nigerian Scam, a/k/a 419

Most of you, like me, have received an email from a member of a Nigerian family with wealth. It is a desperate cry for help in getting a very large sum of money out of the country. A common variation is a woman in Africa who claimed that her husband had died and that she wanted to leave millions of dollars of his estate to a good church.

In every variation, the scammer is promising obscenely large payments for small unskilled tasks. This scam, like most scams, is too good to be true. Yet people still fall for this money transfer con game.

They will use your emotions and willingness to help against you. They will promise you a large cut of their business or family fortune. All you are asked to do is cover the endless "legal" and other "fees" that must be paid to the people that can release the scammer's money.

The more you are willing to pay, the more

they will try to suck out of your wallet. You will never see any of the promised money because there isn't any. And the worst thing is, this scam is not even new; its variant dates back to 1920s when it was known as 'The Spanish Prisoner' con.

Lottery Scam

Most of us dream of hitting it big, quitting our jobs and retiring while still young enough to enjoy the fine things in life. Chances are you will receive at least one intriguing email from someone saying that you did indeed win a huge amount of money. The visions of a dream home, fabulous vacation, or other expensive goodies you could now afford with ease, could make you forget that you have never ever entered this lottery in the first place.

This scam will usually come in the form of a conventional email message. It will inform you that you won millions of dollars and congratulate you repeatedly. The catch: before you can collect your "winnings", you must pay the "processing" fee of several thousands of dollars.

Stop! The moment the bad guy cashes your money order, you lose. Once you realize you have been suckered into paying \$3000 to a con man, they are long gone with your money. Do not fall for this lottery scam.

Advanced Fees Scam (guaranteed loan or credit card)

If you are thinking about applying for a "pre-approved" loan or a credit card that charges an up-front fee, ask yourself: "why would a bank do that?" These scams are obvious to people who take the time to scrutinize the offer.

Remember: reputable credit card companies can and do charge an annual fee

but it is applied to the balance of the card, never at the sign-up. Furthermore, if you legitimately clear your credit balance each month, a legitimate bank will sometimes wave the annual fee.

As for these incredible, pre-approved loans for a half-a-million dollar homes: use your common sense. These people do not know you or your credit situation, yet they are willing to offer massive credit limits.

Sadly, a percentage of all the recipients of

their "amazing" offer will take the bait and pay the up-front fee. If only one in every thousand people falls for this scam, the scammers still win. Far too many victims, pressured by financial problems, willingly step into this trap.

For Sale Items Scam

This one involves an item you might have listed for sale such as a car, truck or some other expensive item. The scammer finds your ad and sends you an email asking for your contact information. Once you provide that, the scammer will re-contact you a day or so later and inform you that they mistakenly sent more than you were asking or offering to pay much more than your asking price. The reason for overpayment is either a mistake or supposedly related to fees to ship the item. In return, you are to send the cash for the difference.

The check or money order you receive looks real so you deposit it into your account. In a couple of days (or the time it takes to clear) your bank informs you the check or money order was fake and demands you pay that amount back immediately.

In most documented versions of this scam, the check or money order was either a forgery or never authorized by the bank it was stolen from. In the case of cashier's checks, it is usually a convincing forgery. If you sent the item, you have now lost the item, the cash you sent with the item, and you owe a hefty sum of money to your bank to cover the bad money order or the fake cashier's check. This particular scam occurs frequently in our area. I have five, different, fake checks in my office that I had the scammers send to me while I played their

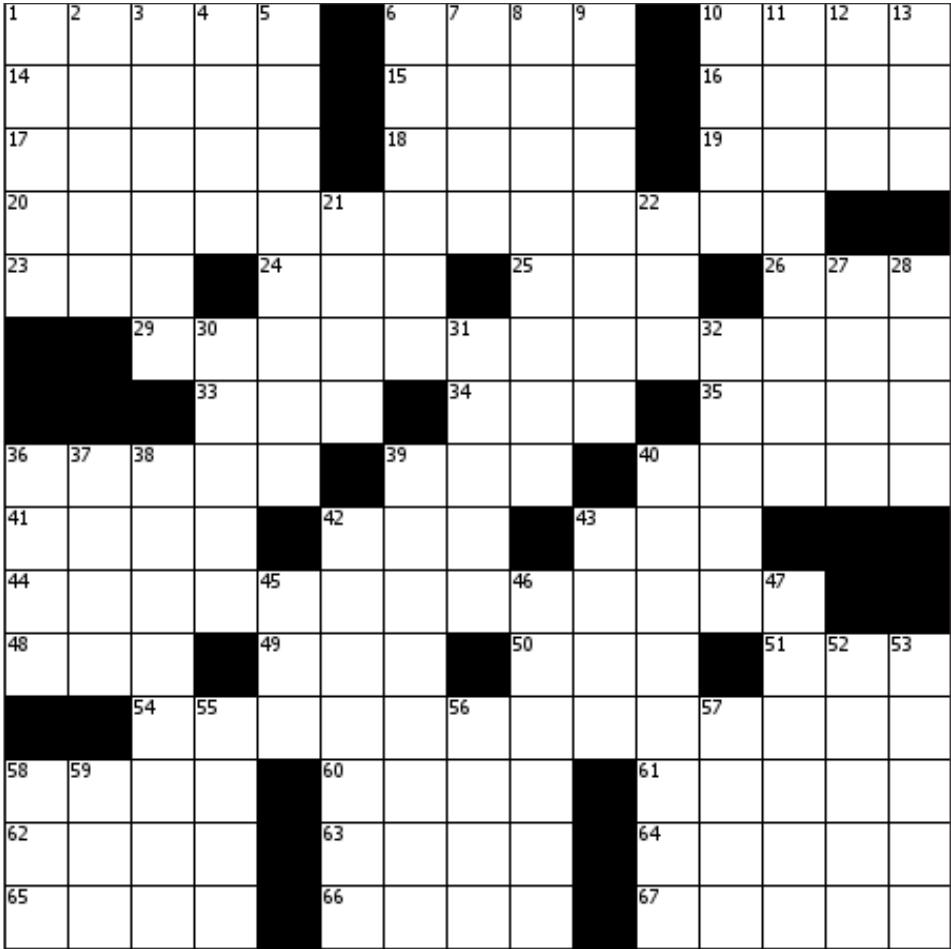

game just to take up their time.

Employment Search Scam

You have posted your resume, with at least some personal data accessible by potential employers, on a legitimate employment site. You receive a job offer to become a "financial representative" of an overseas company you have never even heard of before. The reason they want to hire you is that this company has problems accepting money from US customers and they need you to handle those payments. You will be paid 5 to 15 percent commission per transaction.

If you apply, you will provide the scammer with your personal data, such as bank account information, so you can "get paid". Instead, you will experience some, or all, of the following:

- identity theft,
- money stolen from your account, or
- receive fake checks or money orders for payments which you deposit into your account but must send 85 – 95 percent of that to your "employer".

Do you want to guess what happens then? If you guessed you now owe your bank a lot of money, you would be correct.

Disaster Relief Scam

What do all disasters have in common? They are all real, tragic events where people die, lose their loved ones, or everything they own. In times like these, good people pull together to help the survivors in any way they can, including online donations. Scammers set up fake charity websites and steal the money donated to the victims of

disasters.

If your request for the donation came via email, there is a chance of it being a phishing attempt. Do not click on the link in the email and volunteer your bank account or credit card information. Contact the recognized charitable organization directly by phone or their website.

Please do not fall prey to these predators and become a statistic.

Nevertheless, if you have been victimized by any similar scam, contact your local law enforcement agency and report it. Although these can be difficult crimes to prosecute, law enforcement is tracking these criminals and their con artist techniques.

Finally, the best and most effective way to combat this crime is to share this important information with your friends, family and co-workers. Educating the community about these cons is the first step in stopping these scammers in their tracks.

It's Flu Season



It's Flu Season: CDC Reminds Public That Antibiotics Do Not Treat Flu

(NAPSI)—Flu season is upon us and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

wants patients and families to remember that prescription antiviral drugs, not antibiotics, are the treatment for influenza (flu). Antibiotics do not treat viruses that cause colds and the flu. They are only needed for treating certain infections caused by bacteria.

Remember that the best way to protect yourself and your family from the flu is by getting your annual flu vaccine. It's not too late to get vaccinated.

KNOW WHAT'S GOT YOU SICK

Viruses cause infections like the common cold, flu, runny noses and most sore throats, and none of these are treated with antibiotics. Illnesses like strep throat, pneumonia and whooping cough are examples of illnesses caused by bacteria that can be treated with antibiotics.

ANTIBIOTICS AREN'T ALWAYS THE ANSWER

If you have the flu, taking antibiotics won't help to treat your flu illness. It is important to remember that any time you take antibiotics it can lead to antibiotic resistance and cause side effects.

Antibiotic resistance is one of the most urgent threats to the public's health and occurs when bacteria become resistant to the antibiotics designed to kill them. Antibiotic side effects range from minor—e.g., rash, dizziness, nausea, yeast infections—to very severe health problems, e.g., life-threatening allergic reactions or Clostridium difficile infection (also called C. difficile or C. diff), which causes diarrhea that can lead to severe colon damage or death.

When a patient needs antibiotics, the benefits outweigh the risks of side effects.

Antibiotics save lives and are critical tools for treating a number of common infections like pneumonia and life-threatening conditions like sepsis.

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM INFLUENZA (FLU)

You can protect yourself and others from the flu in three steps.

1) Get vaccinated. Everyone 6 months or older should get a yearly flu vaccine.

2) Stop the spread of germs by avoiding close contact with sick people. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth, and cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue. Clean your hands often with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer or soap and water.

3) If you get sick, take antiviral drugs if your doctor prescribes them.

FIND OUT HOW TO FEEL BETTER

Most healthy people with the flu have mild illness and recover in less than two weeks without needing medical care or antiviral drugs. If you get sick with flu symptoms, in most cases, you should stay home and avoid contact with other people except to get medical care.

If, however, you have flu symptoms and are at high risk of having complications from flu, or are very sick or worried about your illness, contact your healthcare professional. Your doctor may prescribe antiviral drugs to treat your illness. People at high risk of having complications from flu include young children, people 65 years of age and older, pregnant women and people with certain medical conditions.

Save Tax Time & Money

Five Tips To Save Time & Money This Tax Season



(NAPSI)—Taxes are inevitable, but there are many smart ways to save time and money throughout the process. Marsha Barnes, a certified financial social worker, financial educator and certified credit report reviewer, helps identify five important tips to consider:

- 1. Get organized.** Gather all the documents you'll need ahead of time, including W-2s, 1099s, mortgage interest statements, charitable contributions, and paperwork relating to any stocks, funds or properties you bought or sold in 2017. Get out last year's returns, which can serve as a guide. Schedule an appointment with a tax professional or compare the do-it-yourself software you'll need to complete your tax returns on your own. You can also find checklists online, such as the one at GreenDot.com/taxfast.
- 2. Find out which tax breaks apply to you.** Has your living or work situation changed? The number of people you support? Did you get married or have children? Even if nothing has changed in your life, you may have missed credits in the past that you're entitled to. For example, according to the IRS, one out of every five eligible workers fails to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit. If you find out you qualify for the EITC this year and didn't claim it in the past, you can even file amended returns for 2014, 2015 or 2016 taxes. Make sure you take advantage of the deductions that apply to you. The IRS provides a wealth of this type of information online at irs.gov.
- 3. Use direct deposit.** For the fastest and most secure delivery of your tax refund, ditch the paper check. Opt to have your

refund directly deposited into your bank account. Don't have a bank account or don't want to use your primary bank account?

"And since you were smart and filed early, you'll be able to take advantage of all the tax day freebies that companies promote while others rush to beat the April 17th deadline," adds Barnes.

and extends its vehicle life.

3. Neglecting your tires. Your vehicle's tires should be checked frequently for inflation and tread depth. Underinflated tires can wear out more quickly and need to be replaced sooner, plus they can negatively affect safety, gas mileage and performance.

4. Not following a service schedule. Because many car parts and components wear out or become damaged over time, vehicles need to be routinely serviced to perform optimally. Routine inspections and timely repairs will help keep your car running efficiently and help you avoid more expensive repairs down the road.

5. Keeping a dirty car. Allowing your car to go too long without a wash leads to buildup of damaging chemicals and dirt, increases the potential for rust from road salt and interferes with proper visibility needed for safe driving.
